

Eastern Idaho - The Eastern Idaho MSA consists of six counties and has a population of 343,905. Idaho Falls is the largest city in eastern Idaho and serves as an economic hub to all of eastern Idaho and much of western Wyoming. Idaho Falls is known for the Snake River greenbelt that flows through the center of the city. The city boasts world class fishing on the Snake River, and was recently named by National Geographic as one of the "100 Best Adventure Towns" in the US. 


